Eligibility

In order to be eligible for co-option as a Fradley and Streethay Parish Councillor you must be 18 years of age or over on the day of your nomination, a British, Commonwealth, or Irish Citizen, or a citizen of another Member State of the European Union, be registered as a voter in the relevant Parish in which you wish to seek election and meet at least one of the following criteria:

- For the whole of the 12 months prior to election day are Owner or Tenant of any land or premises in the relevant Parish, or
- Your principal or only place of work during those 12 months or more has been in the relevant Parish, or
- You have lived in the Parish or within 4.8 kilometres (3 miles) during the whole of the 12 months.

You cannot seek election/co-option if:

- You work for the Parish or hold paid office under the council which has the vacancy
- You are the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order or interim order
- Have been sentenced to a term of imprisonment in the past 5 years
- Have been disqualified under any enactment relating to corrupt or illegal practices

The Parish Council will use the information provided on this application form to assess your suitability to be a Parish Councillor and by signing this form you consent to the use and disclosure of the information for that purpose.
